**“Mom, I don’t want to go to that church,
it’s boring. I want to go to La Roca,
because they teach the kids there too, not
just the adults.”**

These were the words of one of the 8-year-old girls who has been attending our church with her family. When her mom suggested attending a Catholic church closer to their home rather than making the trek to La Roca, this little girl protested.

We have been going through the book of Genesis on Sunday mornings and have been focusing on how God’s covenant was not just with Abraham, but with his family as well. Part of putting this teaching into practice has been giving a 3-4min. children’s sermon simplifying and summarizing the sermon and praying for our covenant children. Nikki and Rogelia (one of the Peruvians in our church) work hard at developing a program for the young children that expounds on the children’s sermon and includes snacks, music and a bible lesson. When this young girl’s father told us the story of his daughter protesting missing church at La Roca, we were so thankful to see the fruit of these efforts in her little life.

We are excited to work at developing materials for wide-spread use, and to see how God will use these efforts to help in the expansion of his church throughout Peru.
