Thank you so much for your prayers and encouragement in response to our newsletter a few weeks ago. During my 10-day trip to Colombia, the Lord was gracious enough to provide a house to rent and a vehicle. The home we found will not only be perfect for our family, but it also provides a great space as we begin starting a church plant. I can already imagine opening our home for neighborhood gatherings, grill outs, and Bible studies. We were also blessed to find a 2008 Toyota SUV that will not only serve Bonham Academy (our makeshift homeschool name), but also serve as a "bus" for our Colombian brothers and sisters (in the same way that our vehicle in Peru did as well).

Even beyond these material provisions from the Lord, I was able to connect with several people...

-One couple has been driving over an hour to go to church. They ask me how soon we will start planting a church because they are wanting to be a part of a new Reformed church plant.

-I met the next door neighbor of the house we will be renting. Of course he asks where I am from, and I tell him Mississippi. He says he was just in Mississippi last year. I ask him, "Why is that?" All the while thinking, why would a Colombian visit Mississippi of all places? He goes on to tell me that he went there with the mayor of Rionegro because they have formed a "sister city" partnership with Biloxi and Gulfport. This connection certainly isn't by chance!

-A taxi driver insists that I write his phone number down. After sharing what I do as a missionary, the message of the gospel, and our intention to plant a biblical-based, Christ-centered church in Rionegro, he shares with me how he longs for a church community. He wants a church home for himself, his girlfriend, and his two teenage kids.

All of these providential encounters only continue to affirm that we are simply following where the Lord is already at work. I am excited to see what He has planned for us in Colombia.
